



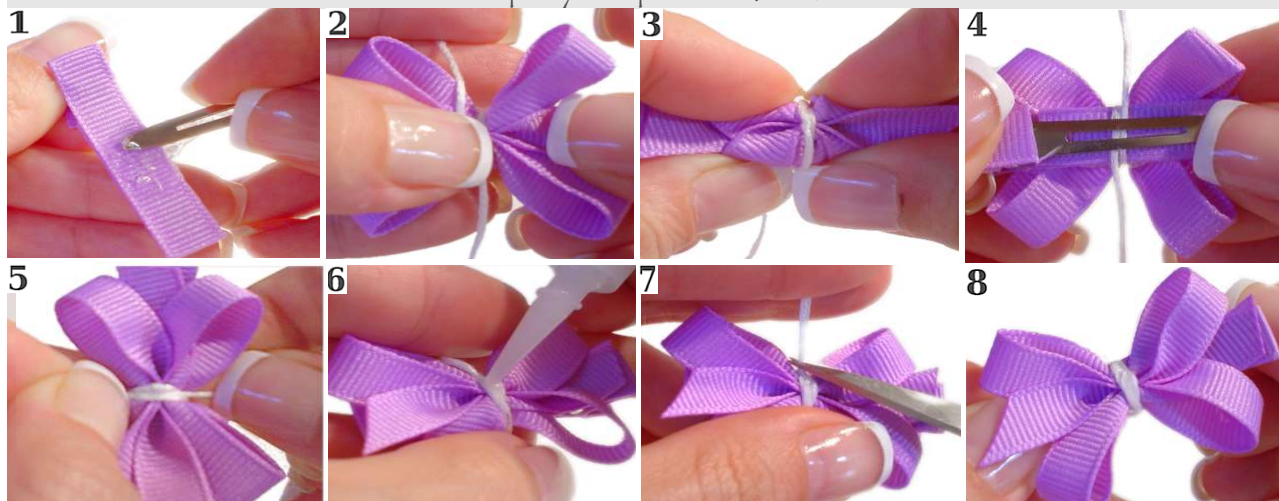
Materials for Applying a Bow to an Alligator Pinch Clip:

- 1 bow
- 1 covered **or** uncovered alligator clip
- quick-drying glue
- wax paper
- 1 extra alligator clip (for applying glue)

LAMB Says...

Securing the bow to the clip is probably the most important step when assembling your bow for safety. We are using a covered alligator clip in the illustrations.

Step-by-Step Illustrations



Applying a Bow to an Alligator Pinch Clip

NOTE: If you are working with a bare clip, catch glue drips by placing a piece of wax paper between the clip's prongs. After the glue sets, you can remove the wax paper.

1. Turning to the top side of the clip, apply glue to the area where you would like to apply the bow.
2. Separate the floss so it comes out on both sides from the center of the bow. Set the bow's center onto the glue-covered area on the clip and press firmly.
3. Before the glue dries, separate the loops and bond in place. If needed, apply more glue under the loops to better secure their placement.
4. After the glue sets, and the bow is bonded to the clip, open the clip and wrap each piece of floss in opposite directions around the clip's top prong.
5. Bring the floss up and around the clip and around the center of the bow. Tie the floss into a knot.
6. Dot the center of the bow and knot with instant glue.
7. Cut and remove excess floss.
8. If you would like to apply a center knot, proceed to pages 7 and 8.
